The 12th Zambia Water Forum and Exhibition will be held from 11th -13th June, 2024 at the Mulungushi International Conference center in Lusaka, Zambia under the theme "Closing the gap: Working towards the attainment of the sustainable development goals (SDGs) targets".

The Zambia Water Forum and Exhibition (ZAWAFE) seeks to continuously raise awareness on the importance of water, sanitation and good hygiene practices. ZAWAFE aims to bring out innovative, feasible and cost-effective strategies to address the inadequacies in water supply, sanitation, environmental and water stewardship.

Water is critical for achieving the SDGs Target and plays an important role in all sectors of the economy. Its criticality is acknowledged in different sectors and within the water and sanitation sector. In order to achieve this, ZAWAFE 2024 will bring together various national and international stakeholders to share best practices on water, sanitation and hygiene by creating a platform where a number of issues pertaining to the attainment of SDG 6 – Clean Water and Sanitation globally and nationally, investments required to meet the aspirations of the SDGs, Climate change and global warming will be discussed among others.

The Forum and Exhibition will encompass keynote speeches, plenary sessions, parallel breakaway sessions and exhibitions. Institutions and Organization are encouraged to register for paid focused sessions to present the interventions and programmes that they are currently undertaking or supporting in line with the forum Themes.

During the Forum, various topical issues pertaining to closing the gap in the water and sanitation sector in Zambia, the region and abroad as well as a number of challenges and solutions will be discussed in line with the 2024 ZAWAFE theme. Therefore, the ZAWAFE Steering Committee now **calls for papers** in line with the above mentioned theme and sub-themes below by the set deadline **31st March 2024**.

Forum Theme:

Closing the gap: Working towards the attainment of the sustainable development goals (SDGs) targets.

 - b. Building climate resilient infrastructure to meet the demands of water supply and sanitation:

 - a. Technological gaps identified in water resources management, climate change and access to WSS services:
 - b. Developing appropriate technologies in service delivery is vital in water resources management;
